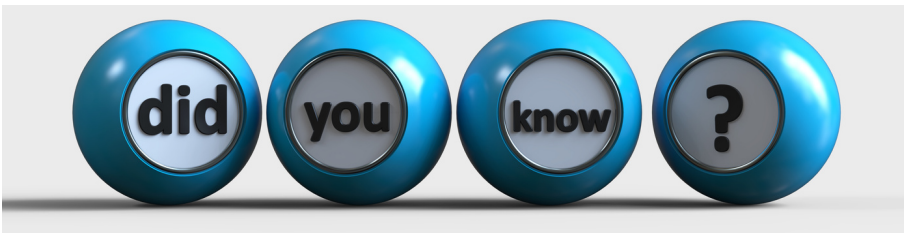

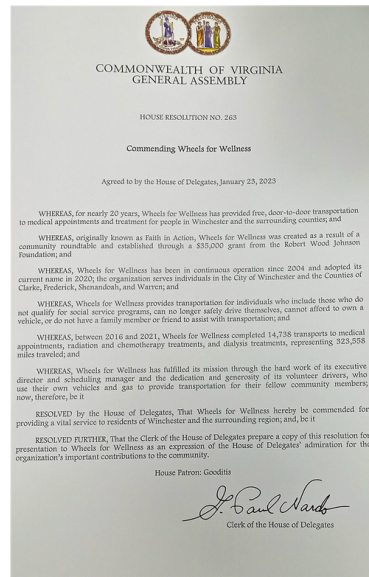

To keep up with the demand I have used every opportunity that has presented itself to recruit new drivers and it will be a priority over the remainder of this year and into next.
